May 8th Using & Understanding the ECERS (R) 6:30-8:30 pm

When you think of the ECERS-R, do you feel a little uneasy? During this class we will discuss each item and specific indicators of the Early Childhood Environmental Rating Scale (R) for children 2 ½ through 5 years of age. Participants will have the opportunity to ask questions and gain helpful information on the ECERS-R. *Bring your ECERS (R) Scales book and All About ECERS Books if you have them (2.0 hours/\$7.00)*

**May 17th Social/Emotional Milestones-Birth to 36 Months:
Building Blocks for Future Learning 6:30-8:30 pm**

First everything is “mine”, then children learn to take turns, and eventually they learn to share. For infants and toddlers this learning happens through relationships and includes developing a sense of self, a sense of self with others, and learning about feelings. All children need an emotionally secure environment that supports healthy development in this learning domain. This workshop examines social/emotional competence as a vital component of later school readiness. Participants will learn how a responsive caregiver can help the youngest of our children form secure attachments, learn to navigate feelings, and begin to develop self-regulation and social skills, the building blocks for future learning. **(2.0 hours/\$7.00)**

**May 24th Preventing Challenging Behaviors:
An Ounce of Prevention is Worth a Pound of Cure 6:30-8:30 pm**

The environment a teacher creates, paired with her knowledge of the children in her care, can prevent many challenging behaviors in young children. Teachers who create positive social environments find that children more easily develop the social-emotional skills they need to succeed. This session focuses on modifications teachers can make in six key areas of the environment that will prevent and reduce conflict that leads to challenging behaviors. **(2.0 hours/\$7.00)**

Developed by the NC Healthy Start Foundation’s ITS-SIDS Project, this session meets state requirements for ITS-SIDS training. Participants will learn to reduce the risk of SIDS through safe sleep practices for infants. Participants will also review Safe Sleep Policy guidelines, NC Division of Child Development and Early Education licensing rules, and maintenance of the proper forms. **(2.0 hrs./\$7.00)**
