Learners will engage in group discussions and activities that explore how to best support infant toddler development and learning using an appropriate tool designed to measure quality. Learners will gain confidence in their ability to provide high quality early learning experiences for infants and toddlers. Learners are encouraged to bring a copy of the spiral bound Infant Toddler Environment Rating Scale-Revised Edition.

The EPR in Child Care Training addresses NC Child Care Rules on emergency preparedness, current best practice recommendations, and guidance on completing the online EPR Plan. The EPR Plan template can be found on the North Carolina Emergency Management website. This training is presented in a two-and-a-half-hour session. NC Child Care Rules require that a designated individual from all licensed centers and family child care homes complete the training and submit a facility EPR Plan. **(2.0 DCDEE contact hours/\$7.00)**
