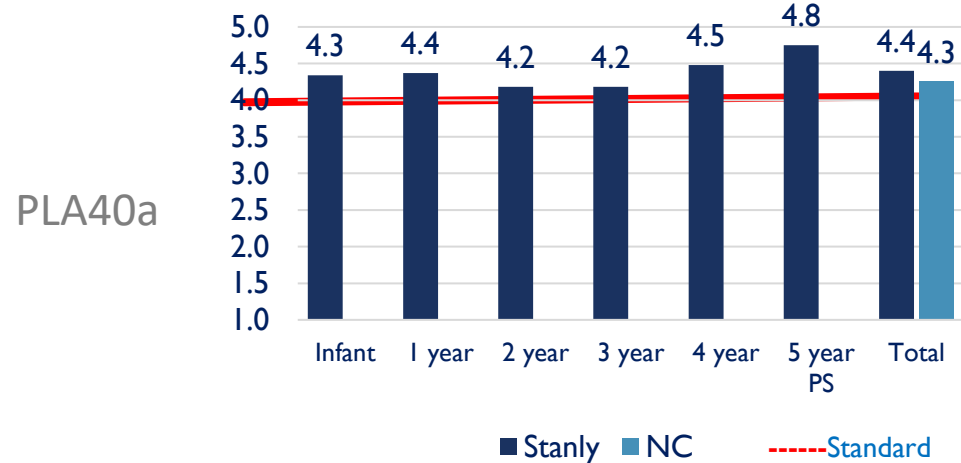

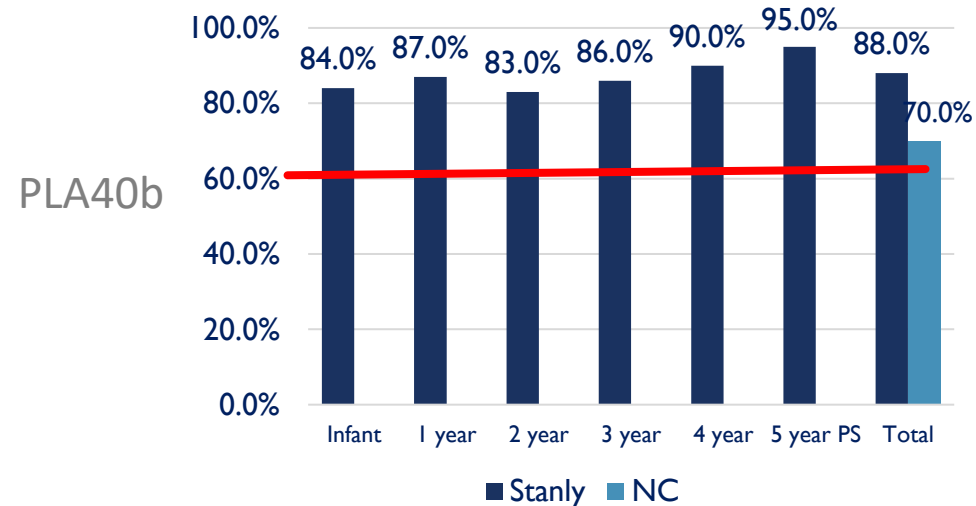
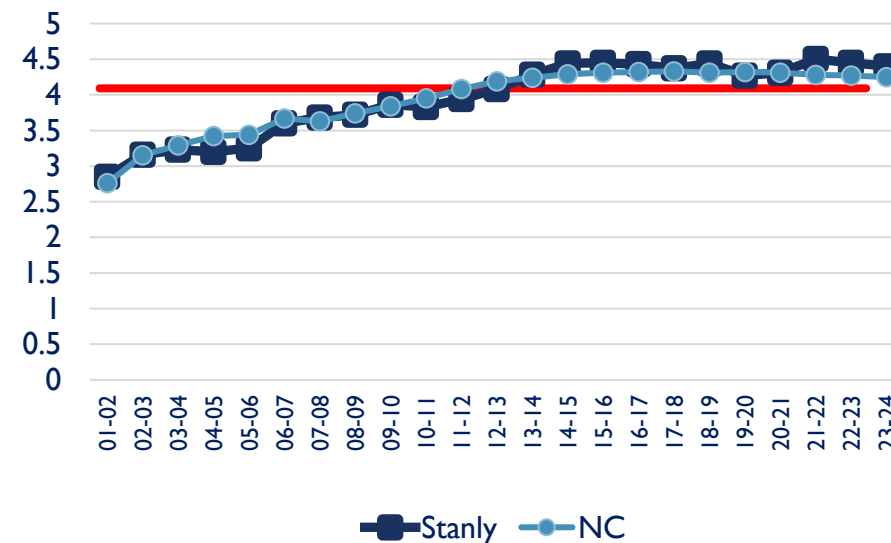

By Age FY23-24



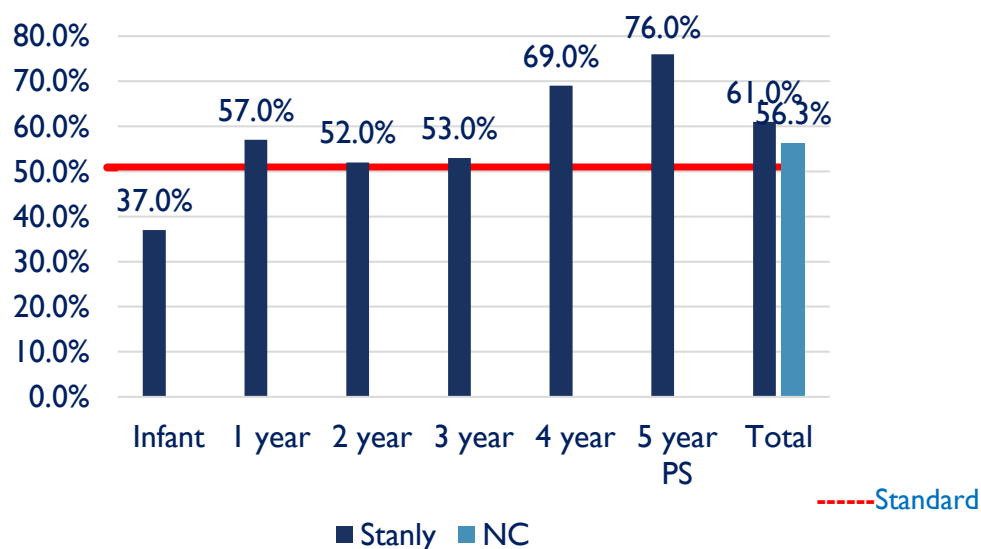
Overall Average Star Rating Trend



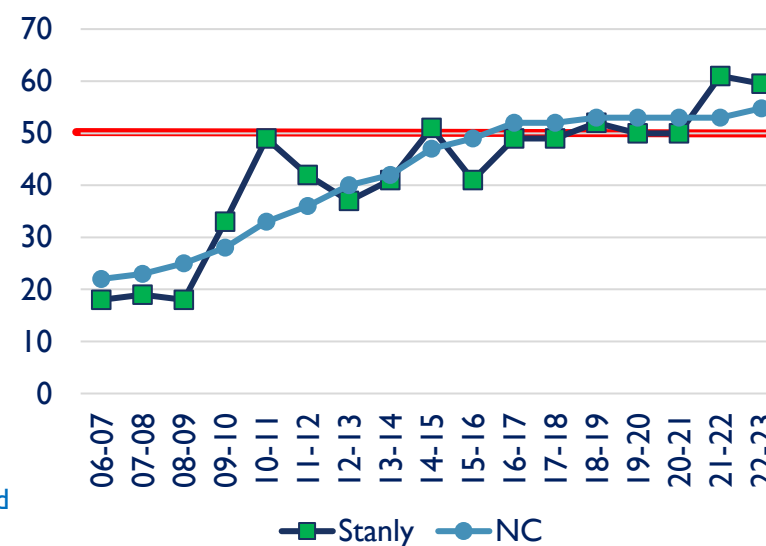

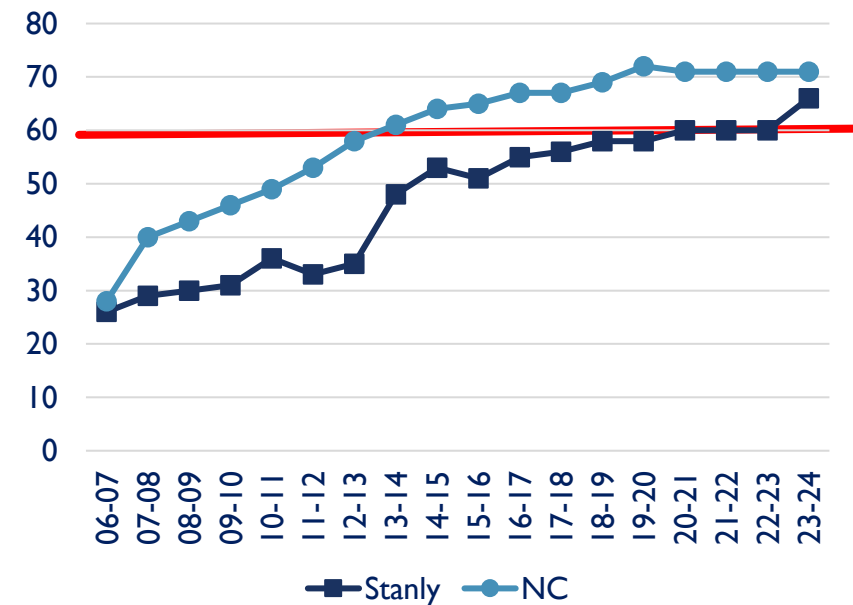

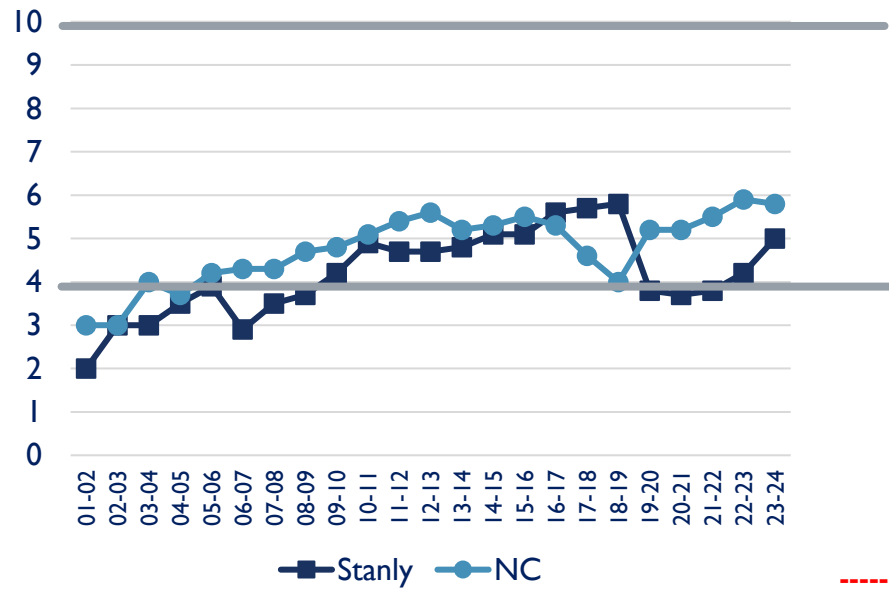

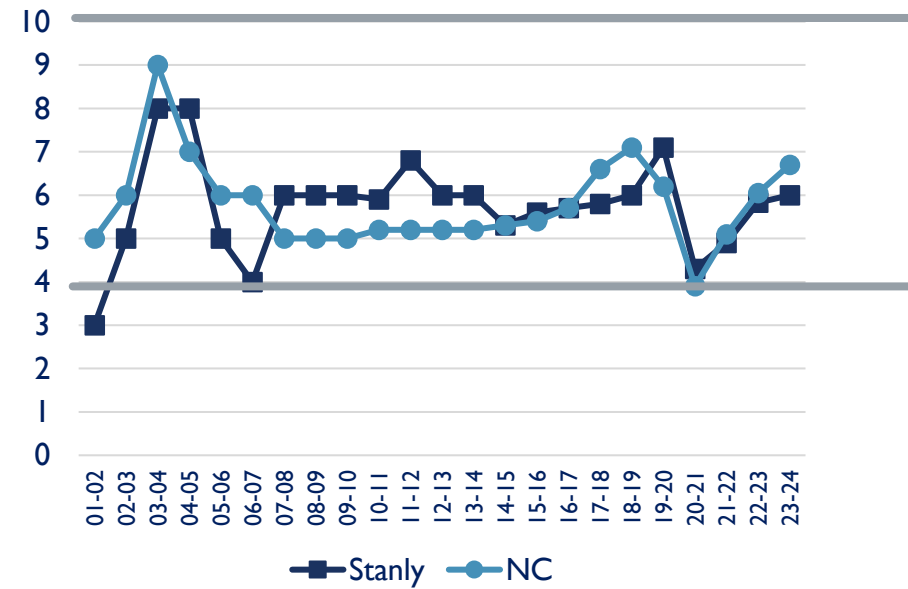
